



Workers' Memorial Scholarship Award **2009-2010**

(Applications are due by March 1, 2009)

Oregon residents who have graduated from any high school or hold a GED and who are receiving benefits as a dependent or spouse of an Oregon Worker, fatally injured or who has incurred permanent total disability on the job, may be eligible to receive the Workers' Memorial Scholarship Award, administered by OR-OSHA, to help meet college expenses.

The deadline for submitting an application for the 2009-2010 school year is March 1, 2009. You can file your application online at <http://www.getcollegefunds.org/> or application forms are available from your local high school guidance counselor or college financial aid department. Applications are also available from the Oregon Student Assistance Commission, Grants and Scholarships Division, 1500 Valley River Drive, Suite 100 Eugene, OR 97401.
